



The A. Keith Smiley Ecology Conference Series

Building upon a strong tradition of past programs, Mohonk Consultations plans to introduce the A. Keith Smiley Ecology Conference Series in 1994.

Former conferences at Mohonk have brought together a unique blend of persons, focused on discussing relevant environmental issues, and, further, on seeking practical solutions to ecological problems.

This new Series will promote local, regional, national and international understanding of ecological issues that affect all of us.

Issues that we plan to address through this Series are:

- 1. <u>River Systems</u>: their importance, impacts of national estuary clean-up programs, user-friendly Greenway trail systems, alternatives to typical transportation, helping to meet clean-air act standards.
- 2. <u>Effective uses of resources</u>: waste disposal, spray irrigation, economically viable recycling efforts, preservation of original genetic strains, and the issue of bio-diversity.
- 3. <u>Community Planning and Land Management</u>: alternatives to standard zoning plans, village and home clustering ideas. Sharing world-wide procedures for managing natural resources.
- 4. Education and Recognition initiatives: telling of successful innovations, of the people who make things work in the ecology field.
- 5. Local topics on preservation of agriculture in the Hudson Valley: better methods of marketing, global trading, how to protect farmland and open space from urban expansion.
- 6. New needs and topics in the future: working closely with the Mohonk Preserve to plan joint strategies on environmental issues.

The Ecology Conference Series intends to promote understanding of and workable solutions for environmental problems, in cooperation with educational, corporate, agricultural and governmental constituencies.
